#### SCHOOL SAFETY POLICY

Peace River School Division - ALL doors to the school will be locked in the safety of everyone within. If you need to pick up your child early or are dropping off from an appointment or are late for school – please use the doorbell and camera at our Main Entrance (Flagpoles location at the south side of the school); also, any visitors and volunteers who need access.



#### **STUDENT DROP-OFF:**

Parents dropping off children for school, please instruct your child to use the **Cross Walk** in the *middle of the bus loop OR* better yet, drop them off at the *north end of the school yard* near the mailboxes and they will not have to crossroads or the bus lane at all. Students will then proceed directly to the grade appropriate entrance. They are not to be using the staff or main entrances unless they are Late. Please do not park on the road to the south of the school (Main entrance)

before or after school as this is very busy with Bus traffic and can get very congested with cars parked on both sides of the road.

**By SMS** – texts will go out to the cell phone numbers we have on file here at the school. If your phone number has changed recently, please let us know! You need to opt into this service as indicated on the attached information sheet.

**By Email** – we will continue to send our weekly email list of activities, however School Messenger will be used for special bulletins.

By Phone – this allows us to send a pre-recorded message to your primary phone number. If there is no answer, the message will be delivered to the other phone numbers we have on file until a connection is made. Please wait for the school-initiated portion of the call to begin as School Messenger will consider the call to be incomplete if you hang up during the introductory portion. Please opt into the SchoolMessenger program – thank you. Please take this opportunity to register your phone to receive important messages via text using the attached instructions.

### Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes:

Our notification provider, SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, referred to as "short code" texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers. If you've ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.
