GRADE 5 & 6 REPORT CARDS:

PowerSchool is currently locked as teachers prepare the Grade 5 & 6 Report Cards. They should be ready for viewing by Wednesday, March 4th evening. Please view report cards through your Parent Portal using the **Browser**. If you choose to use the App to view report cards, you will have to delete and reinstall the App (this is a third party app and doesn't interact with PowerSchool and the portal being locked).



HOT LUNCH PROGRAM
